

2026 League City Lions Club Scholarship Application Information & Submission Rules

The League City Lions Club will award sixteen \$1,000 scholarships in 2026 to deserving graduating high school seniors at the 3 CCISD High Schools in League City. Students' community service, academic achievements, and extracurricular activities in school and in the community are instrumental in our selection of scholarship recipients.

This application is specific to the League City Lions Club and will be used in consideration of that scholarship **ONLY**. Submitting this scholarship application does not guarantee a scholarship. Therefore, you are encouraged to apply for all financial aid opportunities available to you through other sources, including the financial aid office at the college, university, or vocational school of your choice.

Eligibility Qualifications

- You must be a high school senior, Class of 2026, at Clear Creek, Clear Falls, or Clear Springs High School.
- The scholarship must be used for the purpose of studying at an academically accredited two or four-year college/university or vocational school.
- Community service, academic achievement, community involvement, and leadership will be considered in the selection of scholarship recipients.

How to Apply

Applicants must submit a completed application, personal essay, and transcript by email to the email address provided on Page 2. Your transcript does not have to be an official transcript, but the Committee, at our discretion, may ask for an official copy.

Essay Preparation

Your scholarship essay is a very important part of your application. Please prepare an essay answering this question: What was your most meaningful contribution to a community service project, and why? You may also include in your essay your educational aspirations, community service, examples of leadership, and other personal characteristics that make you deserving of this scholarship. *Your essay should be no longer than 350 words.*

Selection of Recipients

- Scholarship recipients will be notified by email.
- Applicant interviews are not planned at this time. However, the Committee reserves the right, if needed, to interview applicants as part of the selection process.

Payment of Scholarships

- A check will be issued directly to the institution where you're enrolled; \$1,000 will be paid for your Fall 2026 Semester upon evidence of enrollment/registration. Awardees may, at their discretion, request that the money be applied as \$500 for the Fall 2026 Semester and \$500 for the Spring 2027 Semester.

Email all documents in MS-Word or PDF format. No documents in JPEG or any other format will be accepted. Texted documents cannot be accepted – they must be emailed as attachments to your submission email. Do not paste documents into your email message – they must be attachments. Your scholarship application will only be considered complete when all 3 documents are received as specified in these instructions.

Application Deadline: April 1, 2026

Apply promptly. All 3 parts of your application must be received by the Committee by Wednesday, April 1, 2026. The Committee highly recommends that completed applications be submitted well before the April 1 deadline to ensure that the deadline is met.
